Goal One: Approval of Draft law on transparency in extractive industry:

Rational: As of February 2018, Mongolia EITI has been recognized as second country, which made progress satisfied with EITI standard. However, as of Validation in 2022 Mongolia EITI received assessment as moderate, being considered as retreat from the previous achievements and a core reason is the fact that the stand-alone law on transparency in mineral resources sector did not pass. Grants from donors such as the World Bank, the Asian Development Bank, and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development played an important role in the successful implementation of EITI in Mongolia during the 17 years from 2006 to 2023.But they now consider in the future the Government of Mongolia should lead EITI and fund it. Within this requirement, a draft of standalone law on transparency in extractive industry was developed and transferred to the Ministry of Justice and Internal affairs for final discussion.

Rational: In 2023, the International Secretariat of EITI has sent recommendations to all member countries to switch to the new standard, and based on it, the report forms have been revised and implemented by companies and related government institutions. The importance is for government organizations and companies to ensure transparency in their operations according to the standards, to adopt and implement new requirements, to make their operations clear, and thus to improve accountability.
