Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences (MNUMS) is one of largest scientific and intellectual centers of Mongolia with 8 schools and 3 local branch schools, other units of research, students of bachelor's and master's degree, professors and scientists, employees.

The history of MNUMS commences since the date of establishment of "Faculty of Medicine" in National University of Mongolia in 1942. Branch schools of Medicine were established in Gobi – Altai, Darkhan Uul and Dornogobi provinces in 1962, 1967 and 1969, which made a great contribution to the formation of the graduate education system in Mongolia.

In the strategic plan for the development of MNUMS in 2015 - 2024, we described our vision "to be a leader in research and quality health care at the international level" and working to achieve this goal determine strategic priorities.

Since the establishment of the Nursing School in 1929 and the Faculty of Human Medicine in 1942 with 14 students, the University became an academic core with a total of about 600 academics and professors and about 8 000 students. **The School of Public Health** is one of the constituent schools of MNUMS and in 1956, the "Department of Hygiene and Health Protection Organization" was established as the foundation of the school, the first admission to the class of hygiene was taken in 1963.

The School of Public Health has a total of 53 people: 6 professors, 8 associate professors, 8 senior lecturers, and 21 lecturers in department of Epidemiology - Biostatistics, Department of Health Policy, department of Health Social Work, department of Social Sciences, department of Preventive Medicine, Environmental Health, department of nutrition studies. In addition, in 2021, a research and development institute was established, which includes 3 laboratories and 3 centers.

The School of Public Health conducts undergraduate and postgraduate courses in 6 fields such as researcher of public health, health social worker, health economist, occupational safety and hygiene specialist, nutritionist and epidemiologist. The program of Public Health accredited by the national accreditation in 2011 and 2018, Occupational Safety and Hygiene program was

successfully accredited in 2022. The advantage of the accreditation is that the accreditation certificate is verified by the blockchain system, which allows the graduates of the Public Health program to continue their studies internationally.

These activities should be carried out in health care institutions to monitor measures to prevent the risk of infection related to health care services, to take response measures in case of infection, to conduct surveillance studies, to identify risk factors, and to develop the knowledge, skills, professional ethics, and attitudes of health professionals and have required skills to work in the field of public health, hygiene, and epidemiology in organizations, constituencies monitoring organizations, industries, enterprises, academic and state administrative organizations.

USING THE STUDY MANAGEMENT AND DATA SYSTEM OF MNUMS

MNUMS uses an associated system of online courses in daily learning activities. This system is to:

- Monitor the learning process of students
- ✓ Select and plan in advance interested subjects
- ✓ Obtain in digital version learning material, homework
- ✔ Posting announcements and news related to any university level scholarships, incentives or courses
- ✓ It is a software to coordinate communication between professors, students, and departments, including communication with professors and learning department.

Regular checking serial information and registration is important for students, because all issues related to study such as registration, displacement, the gap of learning program are regulated by operation of this program. In case of incorrect marks, it is necessary to check with the professor who taught the subject before the next semester starts.

Within 7 days after taking the exam, check whether the marks are registered in the program, and if the marks are not registered, contact the professor of to enter them.

Because it should be noted that the average marks of any scholarship is recorded in this program.

The program can be accessed from anywhere with an Internet connection, and the computer's Internet browser must have Flash player installed and the Internet speed must be at least 512 Mb.

CENTRAL LIBRARY OF MEDICINE OF MNUMS

Central Library of Medicine (CML) is a central medical library of national level serving not only professors, staff, students and researchers of MNUMS, but also doctors and medical professionals working in the health sector of Mongolia.

CML operates with 650 seats, a total of 134,539 books and textbooks, and 17 employees:

Rules of the library

1. Open a client's card:

All new students can get the service from the library by opening a library card. Following documents must be presented to get a library card; national ID card, one copy of recently taken photo, student ID card of MNUMS.

2. Rules of sitting in the reading hall:

- **a)** In case of taking a book to read in the reading hall, you will need to order your book with your student ID card and read the book in reading hall A or B, as indicated. When you leave, you give back your book and seat number and take back your student ID card and library card.
- **6)** In the case of taking books at home, books will be issued to the student program with a username and password.

- B) In the case that students deliberately or accidentally transfer, take or lose table numbers from the reading hall, the right to be served in the library will be suspended for a period of 1-3 months, and the cost of reprinting the lost numbers will be charged to the reader.
- r) Copying, printing and scanning services will be provided at each library unit.
- 3. Ordering books from the orderong section: If the wanted books are unavailable in the reading hall, go to the student program and make an order. Ordered books can only be read in the reading hall on the day. If you take it home, you will be fined.
- 4. **Rules of e-library:** The e-library serves non-printed materials such as professional CDs, DVDs, and slides for viewing and listening purposes. The librarians will check the client's card and get a seat number.
- 5. **Rules of e-library room:** The Internet service of the library is free and students can use it to find and publish the necessary information, enter the library program and make an order, study independently, choose a course, and read e-books.
