

THREE. INCREASING LECTURER'S PROFESSIONAL AND SOCIAL ACTIVITY CAPACITY

3.1. Organize a set of professional courses

Organized 6 joint training sessions with foreign organizations.

1. In March 2019, a 1-day course with lecturers from BATH University in England;
2. In May 2019, a 2-credit international course on "Research ethics and methods of creating academic works" organized jointly with Israel's Hebrew University and Japan's Jichi Medical University;
3. In May 2019, in cooperation with Dr. Hanna Mitter of the University of Illinois, USA, a training for the public on the topic "Healthy nutrition - prevention of diabetes and its complications";
4. In June 2019, in collaboration with Dr. Arthur Frank of the University of Drexel, USA - Occupational Health Training;
5. In October 2019, in collaboration with the John Hopkins University and the University of Colorado Boulder, USA - training on "Exposure to Air Pollution: The Experience of the United States and Peru" and "Design and Application of Air Pollution Measuring Devices";
6. In December 2019, a 2-day meeting and training to define the direction of the PH policy in cooperation with the ASPHER.
