## FOUR. PURSUIT OF ACADEMIC CULTURE AND ETHICAL STANDARDS OF LECTURERS, DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ATTITUDES

### 4.1. Promotion of self-improvement and maturity, walking club

In order to support self-improvement, we are planning to take a test to determine the level of English language knowledge of lecturers and organize training. In order to develop individual and organizational culture, art and sports events are regularly organized every year and involve all lecturers. Also, the following activities are being implemented in the field of socio-psychological and healthy eating of the faculty's workplace. It includes:

- 1. Organizational management, organization, and ethics training for the management staff of MNUMS from the SPH;
- 2. "Strategies to change risk behavior" training
- 3. Burnout syndrome
- 4. Individual psychological characteristics: Temperament, behavior, talents, interests, motivations, needs
- 5. "Ethics of faculty's work" training
- 6. "Workplace stress" course /summary/
- 7. "Research ethics" course /summary/
- 8. "Psychological health of the elderly"
- 9. "Personal financial management"
- 10. "Household Financial Management"
- 11. "Healthy eating" courses were conducted for all teaching staff of MNUMS.

#### Activities related to the university cafeteria:

Within the framework of organizing trainings and discussions for food production and service department management, dietitians, food technologists, cooks, and support staff of hospitals affiliated to MNUMS, with the food production units of the University Teaching General Hospital, the Mongolia-Japan Hospital, and the Central Hospital of Mongolian Medicine, the Department of Nutrition, the School of Public Health, performed 2 internal tests. Every year, regular training is organized for management, dieticians, chefs, assistant cooks and technologists of the university cafeteria and hospital food production department. Also, every time the cafeteria owner is changed, the direction of operation is inspected and a contract is created.

The calories and nutrients of the food in the cafeteria of the MNUMS headquarters were calculated, and the protein, fat, carbohydrates, and calories of 13 types of meals were determined by laboratory analysis. The results were calculated and the poster containing information on those 13 types of meal was prepared and published.

#### Lecturers to work as program, community and council leaders:

Clause 4.3.3 of the Faculty Development Program states that "The membership of professional associations and associations of faculties and doctors will increase by regularly organizing activities supporting professional branches and associations every year" and in the framework of the Clause 4.5. - "increasing the number of of private sector organizations to cooperate with state and government agencies in the field of faculty development" the lecturers of the SPH are working

# 4.2. Organization of legal framework trainings related to employer's work and social welfare by the professional ministry organization

In order to bring public health care services closer to citizens, a web page of the SPH was created, continuously preparing and running the content to upload in the social page (facebook) and organizing various large-scale events aimed at the public, as well as uploading content related to work and social welfare through the website.

- In collaboration with the Ministry of Health's medical professional ethics control committee,
  sets of trainings on the topic of medical professional ethics during disasters were organized in April, May, and June, involving more than 1,600 people from 7 provinces and
  districts.
- 2. The lecturers were included in the training organized by the Anti-corruption Law and anticorruption activities.
- 3. The SPH organized a training course on organizational management, organization, and ethics for the management staff of MNUMS.
- 4. In cooperation with the People's Republic of China, training was provided on the "Labor Law" and the internal labor regulations of MNUMS.
