ONE. BUILD EXCELLENT HUMAN RESOURCES, SUPPORT FACULTY SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, AND IMPROVE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ATTITUDES IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

1.1. Organizing "Learn from each other and sustainable development" training.

Since 2018, training under the name of "Learn from each other and sustainable development" has been regularly organized for meetings and seminars aimed for faculties from School of Public Health and other schools to exchange the knowledge, information, and experiences from others who have received professional training abroad and in the country. A total of 32 classroom and online trainings were organized within the framework of these regular trainings and seminars, and 1,280 faculties participated twice, and 6 times professors and faculties from external organizations came to train.

1.2. Involving faculties in e-/distance learning in professional fields

Faculty development includes professional knowledge, skills, and attitudes about lessons, teaching methods, students, conducting research, and disseminating research results. In order to advance the process of continuously improving their knowledge and accumulating experience based on teaching and research, health care services, such as introduction to production and consumption, faculties are trained in professional fields.

Problem Based Learning (PBL), Medical Education, University of Calgary Master Faculty Training, Test Development, Program Development, Facilitator, Digital Faculty/e-Learning, Teaching-to-Learning, Learning from each other, sustainable development, e-learning technology, SCORPIA, R program, T2C, T2T courses are regularly organized in classrooms and online, and lecturers from the MNUMS are actively participating. It implements the "Mentorship Program" for the newly hired assistants lecturers, includes them in the "Medical Educational Studies" course, and issues the teaching license.

In order to improve the capacity of young faculties to conduct research, faculties were included in international and government-funded Nature Research Academies training and Erasmus+Arrow training to improve English at the academic level.

Since 2018, more than 10 faculties of the School of Public Health have been included in classroom and online courses organized by faculty researchers from countries such as Germany, Australia, Russia, Japan, Korea, the United States, and China. There are 14 faculties who have undergone professional development and training abroad, and 21 have participated in international conferences, seminars and conferences. 132 faculties participated in 12 organized international courses in Mongolia, and a double number of 509 faculties participated in 59 domestic courses and improved their knowledge and skills. We also provide opportunities for professional development, academical degree defense, and post-graduate long-term and short-term training at foreign universities within framework of cooperation with MNUMS.

- Online collaboration with Professor Gregory Gray of the University of Texas and Duke University Professor Jim Zhang in the U01-U2R twin project to establish a "Mongolian Center for Environmental and Occupational Health" of which the main goal is to establish an interdisciplinary research and training center for the promotion of global environmental and occupational health (GEOHealth).
- 2. The project is being carried out in collaboration with Professor Kim Mulholland of Murdoch University Children's Institute, Australia.
- The project has been successfully selected for the United States Fulbright expert program, with the aim of ensuring the coherence of the bachelor's and master's programs of Health Social Worker and strengthening the capacity of faculties and graduates.

4. The joint summer training with the University of Eastern Finland was held on June 15, 2022.

1.4. Implementation of faculty and student exchange programs domestically and abroad

Since 2015, the East Siberian University of Technology and Management has been cooperating with the Department of Health, Social Work and Social Sciences of the SPH in the framework of research, training and student exchange. Since 2018, a cooperation was carried out with the Erasmus Mundus Foundation and the University of Tampere, Finland, implementing faculty and student exchange projects.

- 1. Within the framework of the "Mongolian History, Culture and Tradition" course taught to students of non-professional classes of universities, a student exchange course was organized from 03.2018 to 04.10.2018 domestically. MNUMS, MNUE, and UIA participated. During 5 classes, 50 students of MNUMS participated in MNUE and UIA classes, 20 students of MNUE, 20 students of UIA participated in this activity. The schools organized events such as university campus tour, university museum tour, and inviting the students to participate in the university competition.
- 2. Agnieszka Czajka, a student of the Japan-Poland Joint Information Technology Academy, came to study at the SPH from February to May, 2018.
- 3. In 2019, student exchange was started, 22 foreign students and 19 Mongolian students were included, and student internships were organized in Russia.
- 4. In cooperation with Seoul National University, a student exchange program was organized in January-February 2019, involving 15 Korean and 15 Mongolian students.
- 5. In May and June, in cooperation with the Transbaikal State University (TSU), students of the Faculty of Education and Psychology and the Health Social Worker of the SPH, MNUMS participated in student exchange program. 7 students from TSU and 4 students from the SPH, MNUMS were included.
- 6. A student and faculty exchange program with Finland's Tampere University has started. Within the framework of this project, 1:1 doctoral students and 1:1 faculties from the two countries will study at each other's university.
- 7. In the framework of the project implemented in cooperation with Kuopio University of Eastern Finland, a selection process was conducted in Sep-Oct of 2021, and 1 bachelor, 1 master, and 1 doctoral student were enrolled in the student exchange program. In March 2022, 1 bachelor's degree student, 1 master's degree, and 1 doctoral student of Health Economics major will go for 3 months each.
- 8. On June 15, 2022, as part of a joint faculty and student exchange program with the University of Eastern Finland, Professor Jussi Kauhanen, director of the master's program of the University of Eastern Finland, P. Javkhlanbayar, senior lecturer, associate professor of the Department of Public Health Policy and Economics, gave lectures on "Socio-economic and psychological issues of health inequality" and "Health system, sustainable development goals and health inequality".
